My name is Morgan Persell and I'm the volunteer Lids4Kids Coordinator at Richmond Middle School.

We have a new program we are launching called Lids4Kids. Lids4Kids works along the same lines as Box Tops for Education.

Here is how the program works: Parents, Guardians, Grandparents, PTO/PTA/school organizations or any adult can collect lids received with any Red Cross Pharmacy prescription.

- Use the baggies to save the specially marked Red Cross Pharmacy lids for your kids to take to school and put in the collection bins.
- The school coordinator can bring the lids to your nearest Red Cross Pharmacy retail location and designate which school the lids are for.
- Each lid redeemed in the Lids4Kids program is worth 25 cents, paid to their local school three times a year.
- Help spread the word throughout the community about the positive financial impact Lids4Kids could have for our local schools.

Keep in mind at 25 cents per lid, these dollars can add up rather quickly and turn into much needed items and supplies for our local schools.
